



PARENT INTERACTIONS AND POLICIES

Parents will view me as a dedicated coach who has a genuine interest in their child. Open lines of communication are important and parent concerns should always be addressed in a timely fashion. All parents should be given opportunities to be a part of the Titan football program and the coaching staff should not show favoritism towards specific families. Parents of the Titan football program can expect consistency from the head coach in regards to discipline and the way each player is coached. Parents will also be asked to support our program at the stadium and at home by doing the following:

- 1. Parents please support your son and his role on the team. Not every player will have the same amount of playing time but every player should feel value in being on the team. Negative communication within the home creates negative feelings within a player that might otherwise feel pride in being a Titan football player. "You should be a starter" or "Johnny is not very good...you are better" creates negativity and divides teammates.*
- 2. Communication is important between the Head Coach and assistant coaches with parents but should never happen during practice. Friday nights before, during or after the game are off limits for coach-parent interaction.*
- 3. Our coaching staff embraces diversity and promotes cultural awareness and acceptance on our team. Please do the same in the stands...be inclusive and make our community strong.*
