



TITAN TEAM POLICIES



Player discipline is simply accepting the responsibility of doing what is right. Titan football players represent and reflect their teammates, faculty, coaches as well as the entire Lee's Summit West student body. Titan football players are expected to do the right thing and to think before they act.

"The Titan Five" :

- 1. Don't put yourself in a position where you will embarrass yourself or your teammates with your actions on or off the field.*
- 2. Be on time...being late will not be tolerated.*
- 3. Follow all Federal, State, local, and school rules and laws.*
- 4. Show respect to all teachers, coaches, parents, and adults in authority.*
- 5. Absolutely no hazing or bullying at anytime...anywhere.*

Players will be given "opportunities" after practice to make amends if there has been an infraction. These "opportunities" will be administered by Coach Miller and Coach Johnson. Serious infractions will follow school handbook policy and once a precedent has been set...it will remain consistent in the future.

School Discipline procedure and how it impact the Team:

Players receiving a discipline referral by the administration will have a suspension of play on the week the detention or ISS is served. Here is the breakdown:

- 1. Overtime for missing assignment counts as a Tardy and will be made up after practice with "Titan Reminders"*
- 2. All 1&2 hour detentions given by the administration will result in 1 quarter out.*
- 3. All 4 hour detentions given by the administration will result in a half out.*
- 4. In school detention of any kind will result in at least a 1 game suspension depending on the length of the ISS.*
- 5. Out of school suspension will result in at least a 1 game suspension and possible dismissal from the Titan football team.*
